

Changing the Coolant

We want to prepare your engine for spring and summer by changing the antifreeze. Failure to change the coolant could result in the cooling system leaking and possibly failing.



Most equipment manufacturers recommend that you change your coolant a minimum of every 12 months or 2400 hours.

We will look to see if there are leaks or any damage within the cooling system. We will clean, and refill the coolant with new fluids to maintain maximum efficiency during the hotter months.

- ♦ Flush entire cooling system and refill with new fluid.
- ♦ Inspect for leaks, damages, corrosion and clogs
- ♦ Inform customer of inspection, and recommendations
- ♦ Inspect and repair additional items as needed, per customer approval.
